

E-Tags

Tips & Information

Thank you for purchasing E-Tags from www.EweNmePrintables.com

Please read these tips before beginning your project.

- PRINTING TIPS -

Use Acrobat Reader 5.0 or higher for best results. When printing make sure AUTO ROTATE AND CENTER is CHECKED and that PAGE SCALING is set to NONE. Print your tags on cardstock. You can use craft cardstock or any other shade you prefer.

- CUTTING TIPS -

When cutting your tags use a sharp craft knife and a straight edge on a cutting mat (scissors work ok too). Cut just inside the black lines so they don't show when the tags are finished.

- FINISHING TIPS -

We used a paper punch to punch a hole in the center of the red circle. We also found it easier to line up the hole in the circle by turning the paper punch upside down.

Tie a piece of string, homespun or jute through the hole to attach the tag to your items. If you wish to "grunge" your tags you can use many methods. Tea, coffee, vanilla, paint and walnut ink are just a few. Use the best method for you. You can grunge them before or after cutting - the choice is yours. If you choose to "grunge" your paper after printing, please use caution, as the ink can sometimes run when the paper gets wet.

You can use an emory board or a small piece of sandpaper on the edges to soften them a bit if you choose.
