SUPPLIES

Scrap fabric
Choice of embellishments
General sewing notions

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut fabric 5 3/4" W x 10" L.



2. Mark $\frac{3}{4}$ " at each end on the wrong side.



3. Fold each end over twice $\frac{3}{4}$ " so that the piece measures $5\frac{3}{4}$ "W x $6\frac{3}{4}$ "L. Press the fold.

4. Simply sew across the folds OR embellish outside with rick rack, fancy embroidery, ribbon, etc. across the opening edge of the fold that will face outward (see picture above and below for an example). Size is still 5 ¾" W x 6 ¾" L.



5. Fold in center so that the finished ends are lined up. Run your finger across the middle to get the crease you see in step 6.



6. Unfold to reveal the crease in the middle.



7. With Right Sides Together, center ends to meet in the middle. Pin in place.



8. Sew the raw ends together using a 1/4" seam allowance.



9. Turn Right Side Out. The tissue holder is now ready to fill with tissue.
