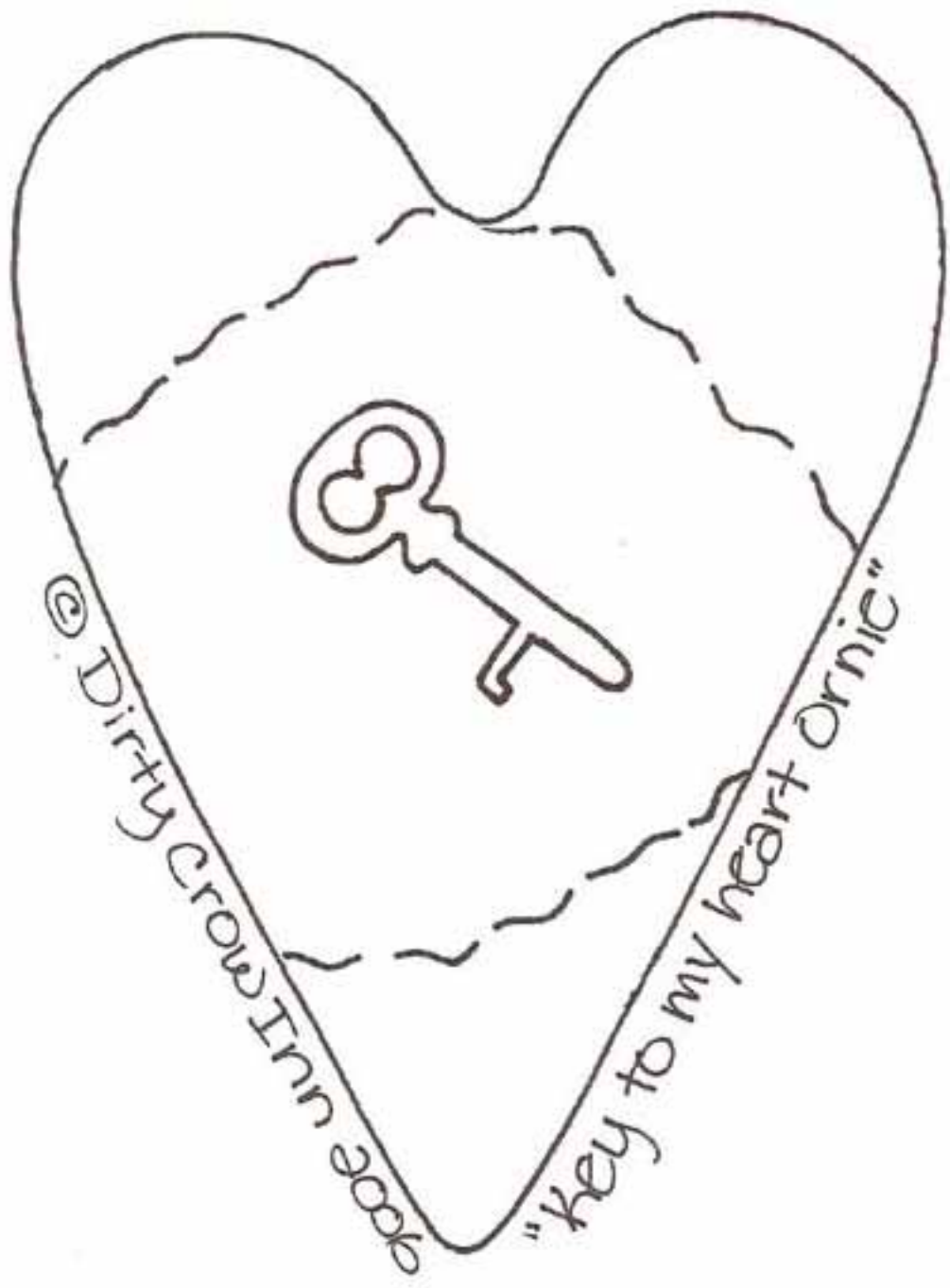
Supply List:

2 Fat quarter muslin	Acrylic paint in Barn Red 1 inch wide paint brush
Small metal key	Upholstery thread
Needle	Poly Fiber Stuffing
Coffee	Cinnamon
Printer	Temporary Spray Adhesive
Sheet of Cardstock Paper	Scissors
Sewing Machine	Pencil
Lighter	Blow Dryer
Modge Podge Glue	

Instructions:

Trace the heart template onto doubled muslin fabric. Sew the heart all the way around, cut a small slit in the back and turn right side out. Stuff the heart using the poly fiber stuffing. Paint the heart barn red and set aside to dry. Stitch up the opening in the back.

Take the other fat quarter of muslin and lay your cardstock sheet on top of it. Trace around the cardstock using a pencil. Cut on muslin on the traced line. Next use the temporary spray adhesive to spray the cardstock on one side. Lay your muslin onto the cardstock and make sure it's smooth. Trim any excess threads around the edges to prevent it from getting hung up in your printer. Next, place the fabric/cardstock sheet in your printer, open up the handwriting image and click print. This will print the handwriting onto your fabric. Set it aside to dry for a few moments. Or you can use a blow dryer to dry it quicker. Cut a piece from the handwritten fabric that will fit onto your heart. Mix one part water with one part coffee. You can coffee stain the handwritten fabric either by dipping it directly into the coffee or using a spray bottle to spray it on. Set it aside to dry or use a blow dryer to speed up the drying time. Once it's completely dry very carefully use a lighter and burn the edges of the fabric. (Caution: Be very careful that you don't start a fire. Be sure to have a pan of water nearby also). Take the heart and brush on some modge podge glue on the front. Position your handwriting fabric onto the heart and smooth it out. Next put the metal key on the front and take your upholstery thread and needle and stitch it on. The last step is to rub it here and there with cinnamon and stitch a large loop in the upper back so it can hang if you want to use it as an ornament. You can also use them as bowl fillers. Hope you enjoyed making these simple and fun hearts!
