

Materials needed:

- Weaver's cloth
- Small no-slip hoop or gripper frame
- Punch needle of your choice [The Cameo Ultra Punch small needle was used for this pattern]
 - Bottle cap [1 1/2" size]
 - Pin back
- Sharp embroidery scissors and large fabric scissors
 - Fabric glue
 - Thick white glue
 - Krazy glue extra strength gel
 - Small piece of off-white waxed linen
 - White Quilting thread
 - Large eye sewing needle
 - 2 small green beads

DMC Medicis wool thread:

- *[Two strands of thread is used throughout the design.]
- #8322
 - #8300
 - #8101
 - #8930
 - Black [Noir]



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Punch Needle Bottle
Cap Kitty Pin

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1. Place the weaver's cloth in a No-slip hoop or gripper frame, making sure it's drum tight.
2. Using a sunny window or light box, trace the design onto the center of weaver's cloth.
3. Thread punch needle with DMC #8300 [brown] and punch the outline of the kitty's spots, then fill it in.
4. Thread punch needle with DMC #8101 [red] and punch the kitty's nose [2 rows close together].
5. Thread punch needle with DMC #8322 [gold] and punch the outline of the kitty's face and fill in.
6. Thread punch needle with DMC #8930 [blue] and punch just inside the circle, outline the kitty's face and fill in.

Kitty face details:

- * When design is completed, keep it in the hoop/frame. Thread sewing needle with quilting thread and attach beads for eyes. [see picture for placement]
- * Separate waxed linen to 2 strands, thread sewing needle and stitch onto kitty face for whiskers. [Only two stitches are needed, starting from the loopy side [front] and then from back to front.]
- * Using DMC Black wool thread, add mouth lines

7. Apply fabric glue to the backside [non loopy side] and 1/4" outside the design. When glue is thoroughly dry, take the fabric out of hoop/frame. With sharp scissors, holding the good, loopy side of the fabric facing you, trim as close as possible to the last row of punching without cutting the loops.
8. Glue piece into the bottle cap using a thick white glue. Allow to dry.
9. Lightly sand the back of the bottle cap and Krazy glue pin back in place.

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
