

## Boutique Tissue Box Cover Pattern 009

Sew Practical 2007

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**Read all instructions & review all diagrams & pictures before beginning this project.**

### Supplies

2 coordinating fat quarters  
Optional scrap fabric for appliqués  
Matching thread  
Scissors  
Pencil and ruler

### Non Rag Style Cover

- Cut (2) pieces for top 5 ½" x 5 ½".
- Lay pieces with **right** sides together.
- Draw diagonal sew lines leaving about 1" in the center that will not be sewn. This will be the opening later to pull the tissues through. See diagram below as an example.
- Once you've sewn the 2 top pieces together, fold on sew lines so that the right sides are now on the outside forming 2 triangles. Press to hold in place.
- Optional: Add fancy stitches along the sides of the center seam of the top piece like the eyelet stitches in the picture above. Set top piece aside.
- On doubled fabric with **wrong** sides together, cut 4 side panels 5 ½" W x 6" L each.
- Lay out the panels as shown in the diagram below.
- Attach any appliqués.
- Tuck the bottom of each front and back panel under about ½" to hide the seam between them.
- Hem in place about ¼" from the bottom edge.
- Now, sew the seams of the panels so they will be on the **inside** using a ½" seam allowance. Trim to ¼" after sewing.
- Do not sew into a box form yet.
- Attach the top with the seams facing inward using a ½" seam allowance again. Trim to ¼" after sewing.
- After the top is attached, you can sew the last seam of the panels together.
- Wash & iron if necessary
- Place over a boutique tissue box. Pull tissue through the opening you left in the top.

## Rag Style Cover

- Cut (2) pieces for top 5 ½" x 5 ½".
- Lay pieces with **right** sides together.
- Draw diagonal sew lines leaving about 1" in the center that will not be sewn. This will be the opening later to pull the tissues through. See diagram below as an example.
- Once you've sewn the 2 top pieces together, fold on sew lines so that the right sides are now on the outside forming 2 triangles. Press to hold in place.
- Optional: Add fancy stitches along the sides of the center seam of the top piece like the eyelet stitches in the picture above. Set top piece aside.
- On doubled fabric with **wrong** sides together, cut 4 side panels 5 ½" W x 6" L each.
- Lay out the panels as shown in the diagram below.
- Attach any appliques.
- Sew the seams so they will be on the **outside** using a ½" seam allowance. Trim any noticeable excess.
- Do not sew into a box form yet.
- Sew a ½" seam across the bottom.
- Attach the top with the seams facing outward using a ½" seam allowance again. Trim any noticeable excess.
- After the top is attached, you can sew the last seam of the panels together.
- Clip the seams carefully, wash & iron if necessary. If you don't want to wash, use a clean soft bristle toothbrush to rub out the excess of loose strings.
- Place over a boutique tissue box. Pull tissue through the opening you left in the top.

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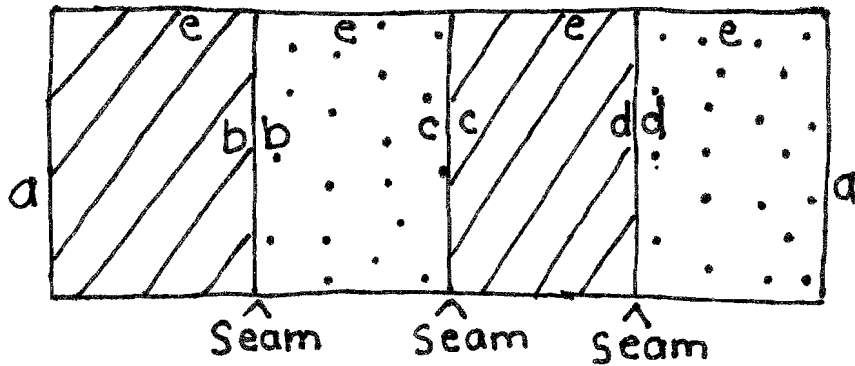
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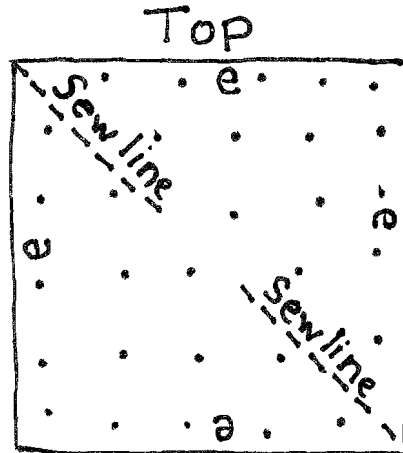
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Boutique Tissue Box Cover

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side panels - 2 pieces per panel



Connect "a" seams after attaching the top at all "e" locations.



Sew right sides together.  
Fold on sew line so that right sides are facing outward.  
Press. Fancy stitches look pretty on either side of the center seam after pressing.
