



Keiko the Bear

Supplies:

felted wool or crafting felt

embroidery thread

stuffing

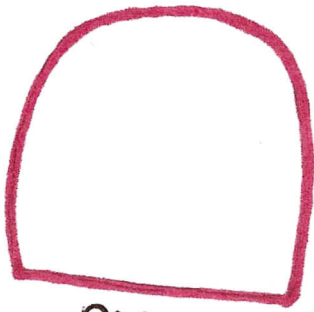
hand sewing needle/scissors

This softie bear was made with felted wool and craft felt. Cut the pattern provided. Cut 2 pieces of the head. Cut 2 pieces of the body. Cut 2 pieces of the ears and one piece for the nose. Start with the bears body. Take both pieces and lay them on top of each other. Start sewing the body closed using a blanket stitch. Start your stitching at the start of the neck. (not closing the top part of the neck, leave that open, this is where you will stuff the body when you have finished stitching.) Stitch all the way around until you get to the neck then end your stitching. Stuff the bear. I used a pencil to get the stuffing in that small opening. Use a little stuffing at a time. Next take one of the head pieces. This will be the front of your doll. You will need to stitch the nose in the center of the face. I then made a french knot for both eyes. Then take the other piece that is the back of the head and make a small slit with your scissors. This is where you will place the neck of the body. Now take both ears and place them in between the front of the face and the back of the head. I pinned them in place and then sewed a blanket stitch all the way around the head. The last part is to place the head on the body stuffing the neck into the hole. Whip stitch the neck and the body closed. Your finished.

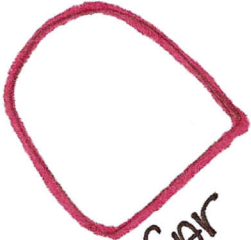

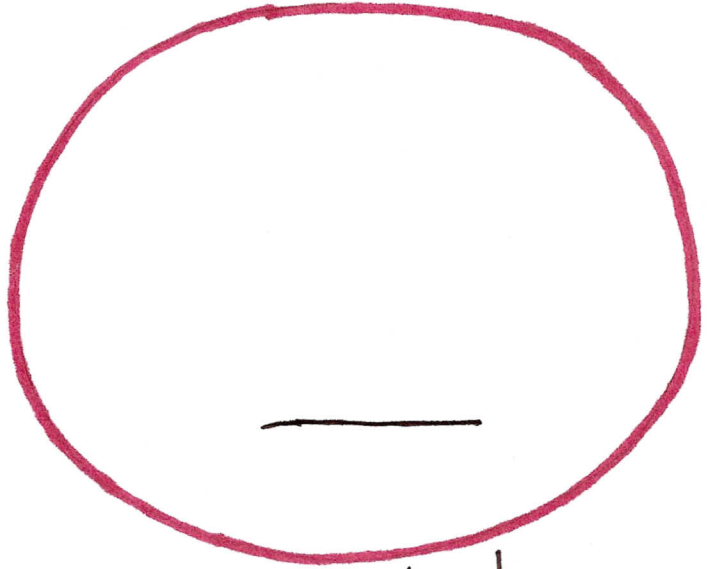
