Supplies:

Scraps of coffee stained Muslin

Black paint

Stuffing

Embroidery Thread in Black

Cinnamon

Stiffy

Burnt umber paint

Cut out the pattern and lay on your muslin. With a pencil draw around the pattern following the outline of the crow. This will be your stitching line.

Sew up the crow leaving open where indicated on the pattern. Clip the curves and stress places in the material. Turn right side out and stuff firmly. Whip stitch the opening shut.

Using the embroidery thread make a knot and go in where the eye would be and out the other side do this a couple of times and come out the other eye from where you originally went in at and make a knot then cut off excess thread.

Next with watered down black paint you will paint the crow and set aside to dry. When dry mix a little stiffy with some water and add a drop or two of burnt umber paint the more paint the darker the crow will turn out. Mix this really good so no globs remain. Paint each crow and allow to dry. Then rub cinnamon all over them and your done.
