

Give Thanks Turkey

(***)Indicate supplies you can find on my site.

Supplies Needed:

- Fiberfill stuffing
- ***6mm black beads for eyes (2)
- ***Fabric-- Muslin, wool (red & gold)
- Basic sewing supplies
- Paint -(all paint is Apple Barrel brand unless indicated) burn red,navy blue,antique gold, hunter green,black,burnt umber.
- Americana Brand- traditional burnt sienna(body color)
- ***gruby tag (#1)
- Letter stamps, leaf stamp
- Kitty litter
- Two barn red buttons.
- Sand paper

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Give Thanks Turkey

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Directions:

Make a template for your pattern onto tracing paper or cardstock. Trace the pattern onto fabric. The 1/4 seam allowance is included in this pattern. Sew body piece where shown on pattern and box in bottom (see "box bottom"). Cut a slit as shown on body through 1 layer of fabric. Paint body burnt sienna and allow to dry. Now add 1 cup of kitty litter to bottom of body and fill the rest with stuffing being sure to stuff firm. Sew opening closed. Your opening needs to be in the back of the turkey. At the back side of the head go in with your needle and sew two 6mm black beads on turkey face as shown in pattern. Now sew two black lines for eye brows. Now end off at the back of the head. Do not worry about this showing, your hat will cover your stitching. Now place wool waddle on face and hand stitch on top of that. Start at the "v" of the heart and hand stitch on being sure to secure waddle to face only at the top, the rest of the waddle will not be stitched to face. It just hangs there. Now finish stitching heart to the face.

Hat

Cut hat brim from double muslin and hat tube on the fold as shown in pattern. Sew hat tube on the side where dotted line is in pattern, do not turn. Now get your tube and hand sew a gather stitch on one end and pull tight and end off. Now you may turn the tube. Whip stitch the other end of the hat to the inside circle of the hat brim. Pint hat black and allow to dry. After hat is dry, sand to get an aged look. Cut buckle from gold wool and hand stitch to hat. Set hat aside.

Box in Bottom

To make a box bottom you will need to take the body section of the turkey and sew all the way around the turkey except the bottom. Then take your scissors and make a small cut in the fabric. This will be the back of your turkey. This allows you to sew the bottom and stuff from that hole. Sew the bottom of the turkey closed. Then you will need to take your turkey bottom and flatten the seam you just closed, until a point forms on the ends. Even out the point till it look like an even triangle and then sew about 1/2 inch in. Do the same to the other side and clip the triangles off. Now you have a box bottom.

Feathers

Cut six feathers from double muslin and one from batting for each feather. Sew together and turn. Tuck open end in and sew opening closed. Be sure this step is done neatly because it will show. Now sew one line down the center of feather as shown on pattern. Now paint your feathers all the different colors and allow to dry. Sand your feathers lightly. Glue the feathers to body as shown in pattern.

Finishing Touches

Place some stuffing in the hat so it will sit good on the head. Glue hat to head and rub some cinnamon on the hat to give it an aged look. Now stamp "Give Thanks" on a #1 grubby tag and tie on turkey neck.

Finishing Touches

Thread two barn red buttons and end off at back side of the buttons. Now glue both to turkey tummy. Now stand back and look at your cute turkey!

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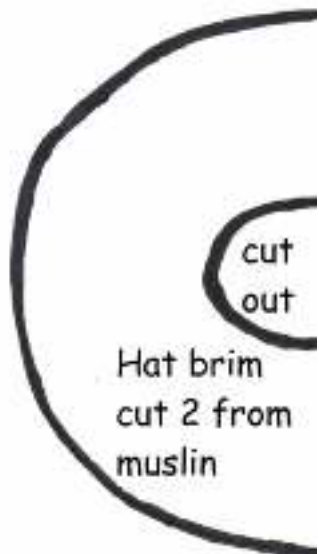
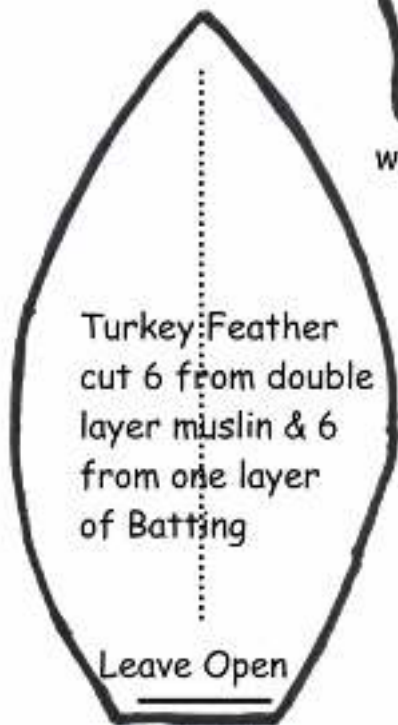


buckle cut 1

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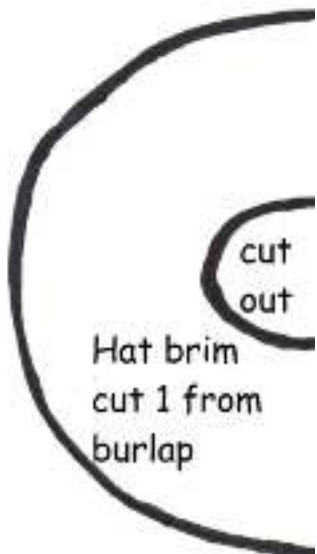


buckle cut 1

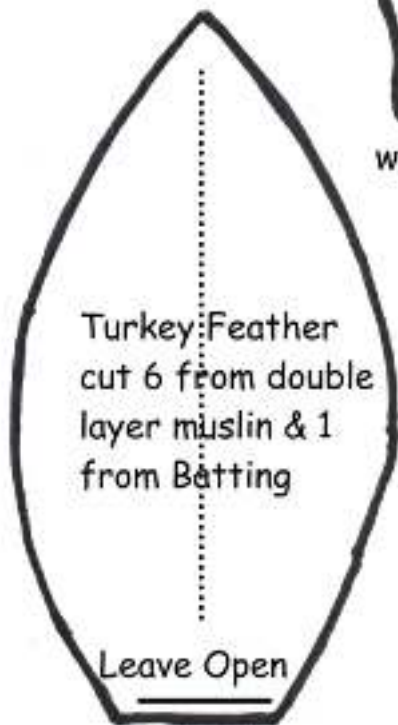


wattle

Leave Open



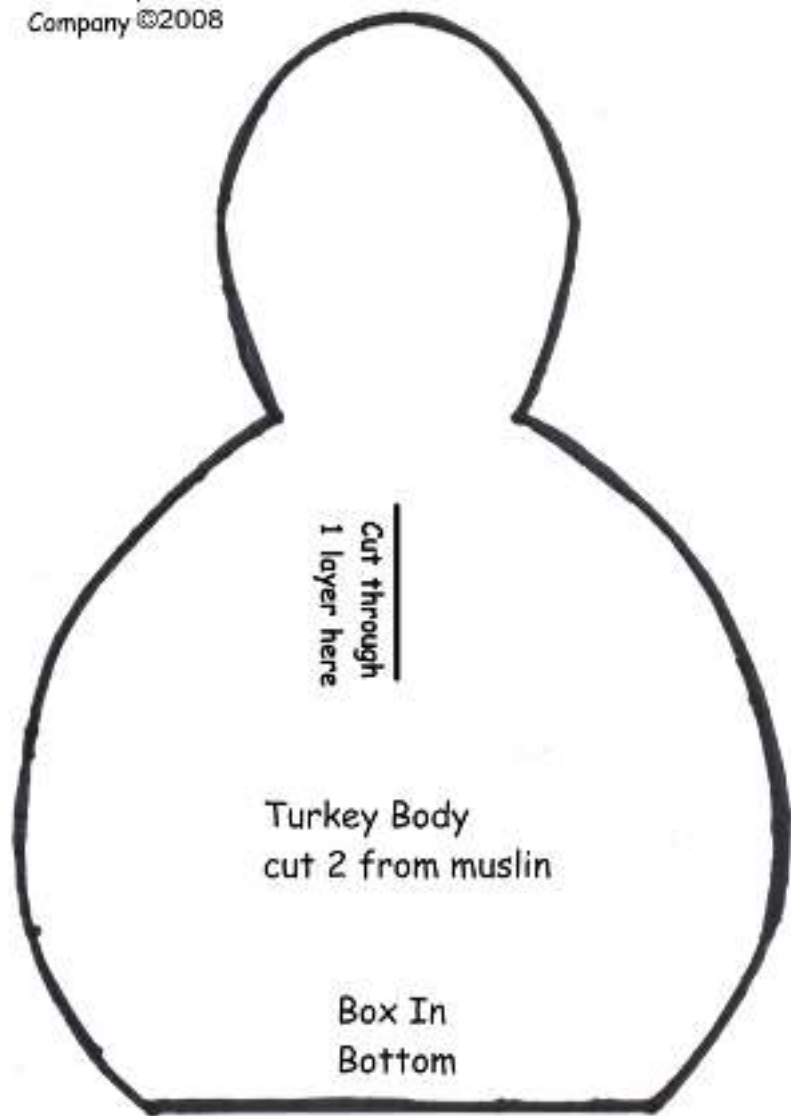
Hat tube

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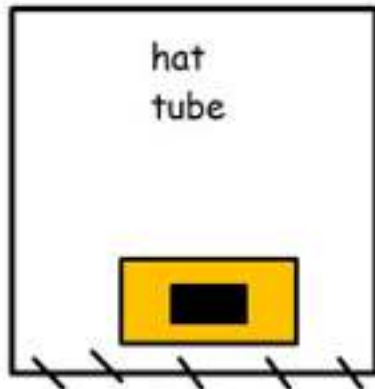
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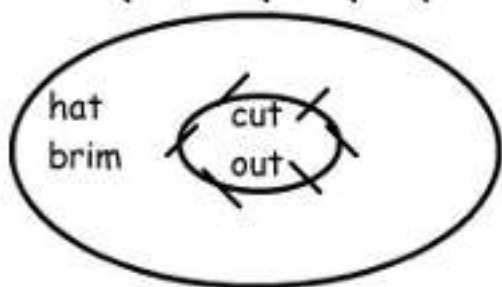
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whip stitch hat tube
